- Purpose:

To encourage young scientists (graduated students) who presented excellent quality papers



▪ **Criteria for Qualification of the Awardees**

- 1) Excellent quality of the paper with high priority and probable impact on the livestock production in the home country.
- 2) Presentation skill with well arranged and convincing speech and good preparation of slides or posters.
- 3) Country of origin of the presenters: Developing countries
- 4) Presentation category: oral and poster presentations
- 5) Age rule: definition of “young scientist”

Age younger than 40 can be considered as young, but younger than 35 is preferable. Position of the candidate in a home university must be lower than lecturer or equivalent position in a research institute. The position comes before age.
